CareCanvas



The <u>University of Toronto Department of Family and Community Medicine</u> and the <u>POPLAR network</u> are launching a new tool to support practice improvement.

<u>CareCanvas</u> is an interactive web-based dashboard that that summarizes clinical information from your practice EMR to make it easier to care for your patients.

What can CareCanvas do for you?

CareCanvas **summarizes over 15 quality of care measures** including information on diabetes, hypertension, prescribing, and more. You can see trends in your practice over time and can compare your practice to your peers. For some measures, you can see differences in care by age, gender, and neighbourhood income.

CareCanvas makes it easier for you to **catch up on chronic disease and preventative care.** Physicians can download a list of at-risk patients who would benefit from follow-up.

CareCanvas can be a source of data to help you meet the CPSO QI program requirements and help you earn MainPro+ credits.

CareCanvas is private, secure, and available at nocost.

To access CareCanvas, physicians need to use Telus Practice Solutions, Accuro, or Oscar and contribute their data to one of the seven Practice Based Research Networks that make up the POPLAR network.



Starting in November, CareCanvas will be available to existing UTOPIAN contributors, with plans to expand the program to all of POPLAR in early 2023.

There is no limit to the number of physicians that can sign up and the value of CareCanvas will grow as more physicians participate and contribute data to POPLAR. **Sign up before December 31, 2022**, to ensure you receive a dashboard with the next release.
